HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION

This year, hundreds of women and children visited the Drop-In Program at our Louisville campus to use the restroom, take showers, receive mail, do laundry, store personal belongings, and occasionally eat a snack or a meal.

In addition to providing for many life-sustaining and dignity-restoring physical needs, we also provided intentional spiritual care for those who were interested in a redeemed life through faith in Christ. Staff and volunteers share the ministry of their presence day in and day out.

The Drop-In Program welcomed anywhere from 12 to 40 women and children a day—guests who were in dire need of a safe, clean, and welcoming space to be. This program remains the only Christ-centered daytime service for homeless women and children in our community.

We took additional steps this year toward our vision of offering residential services for women. We pray the Lord will guide our steps as we seek to provide holistic, high-impact, Christ-centered care to everyone – male and female – in need.

These services are geared toward individuals and families who are at risk of homelessness and in need of a holistic approach to their physical, psychological, relational, and spiritual concerns. Clients are immersed in Christian community, led by our team of professional ministry staff, and supported by caring community volunteers.

We are humbled to have been able to care for 186 clients, providing:

- 128 intake sessions
- 369 counseling sessions
- 162 case management sessions

Join us in praising God for his redeeming work in the lives of 8 clients who professed faith in Christ! It was our joy to watch these individuals be reconciled to God and, with the assistance of our staff, with their families and communities, as well.

HOMELESSNESS RECOVERY

This year, the residential LifeChange Program at our Louisville campus provided the most rigorous and holistic care it ever has.

In the 45-day *Stability* phase (launched in February) we developed relationships with 165 homeless men who were otherwise unsheltered – literally sleeping on the streets. We helped them consider a different future, and 6% took the courageous step to continue in the program.

In the four-month *Recovery* phase, we faithfully journeyed alongside 138 residents as they came to grips with a lifetime of sin and suffering. But we didn't stop there: We also shined the light of the gospel into the darkest corners of their story. Of those residents, 13%* successfully completed the phase.

In the year-long *Transition* phase, we continued to care for 25 residents as they moved toward interdependent living and reconciled with God, family, and community. Of those residents, 36%* successfully completed the phase.

*Success rates do not account for residents who entered the phase in the prior year or who may complete the phase in the following year.
